

Policy of Extension Education Cell

Introduction

Extension education is that type of education which is extended out into the local population, especially in the rural areas where there are less educational institutions providing formal education is available. It is usually given to adults who are already engaged in activities, primarily agricultural.

Extension education is usually applied in sectors like agriculture, farming, fisheries, dairying, animal husbandry etc. Saraighat college has been emphasizing on extension education as one of the dimension of the institution, thereby encouraging the students and the faculty members to undertake extension works and programmes. The college authority encourages the faculty members to organize extension lectures, awareness programmes, workshops and seminars on socially relevant problems such as Environmental pollution, HIV/AIDS Awareness, Drug abuse, Cancer, Health and Hygiene, Primary Health check-up camps, Cleanliness drives etc. The NSS and NCC wings of the college are involved in all such activities.

Objectives:

1. The main objective of the cell is to organize awareness/training programmes in the fringe villages on HIV/AIDS, Cancer general health and hygiene, drugs and substance abuse, mental illness, Govt. schemes etc. In all such programmes, the students should be encouraged to participate so that their organizing, creative, aesthetic and leadership qualities may be developed.
2. The cell should encourage the faculty members and students of every department to participate in extension activities at least twice in a year.
3. The cell may adopt at least one backward village of the locality.
4. The cell may adopt at least five to eight higher secondary/high schools of the locality.
5. Any other extension programme as deemed fit to be undertaken.
